



LERISSE FAMILY MISSIONARIES TO HAITI

November/December 2012

Dear praying Friends and Supporters,

We began 2012 well and by God's grace we have ended well. When we first began the Living Baptist Church of St. Marc my wife and I were the only married couple. In November of this year, the pastor of the St. Marc church had a meeting with all of the married couples and 24 couples were present! This blessed our hearts so much as we remembered the many battles that we fought trying to teach our people what God's word says about marriage. The Saint Marc church is going forward under the present leadership and it is a blessing to see.

In the D.R. Church we closed the new year by baptizing 12 converts. Previously when we had a baptismal service, we would do so at the end of a Sunday service. However, each time we did that, we spent HOURS just to baptize because of the satanic manifestation that would take place. For this last baptismal service, we did so on Saturday evening. As we do every Saturday night, we prayed, sang hymns, and read Scriptures together for two hours and afterward we had the baptism service. Everyone was baptized with no problems until we got to the last adult lady who is in her 60s. As soon as she touched the water, this evil spirit came over her and she was dragged out of the water. I lay my hands on her prayed over her and she came to herself, she confessed Jesus Christ as her Saviour and was baptized for His honor and glory!

On the evening of our last service before our furlough, we had a feast at the church and my wife's Junior church stood in front of the church and quoted over 30 Bible verses and sang. How it blessed our hearts to hear and see these children who knew nothing about anything when we came. They were closed in their minds and spirits and to see them stand and quote verses and sing was a victory for our Lord. Of the 45 children that are in our church, over 30 have received Christ as their Saviour. And those who received Christ did so by coming to my wife or me telling us that they wanted to be saved.

God is doing a work among our people that only He can get credit for. A young man from the Saint Marc Church is pastoring in my place in the D.R. during our furlough, another preacher boy from the St. Marc Church just enrolled in Landmark Baptist College in FL, and yet another preacher boy from the St. Marc Church will be graduating from Bible college in May. The Leadership of the Saint Marc church were all saved, baptized and trained in the Saint Marc Church. To God be the glory, great things He hath done!

Our family has begun our travels in the States reporting to our supporting churches and seeking help for the next phase in establishing the Haitian Christians.
