Dear Friends,

February was a great month! The church attendance is growing fast with the two Sunday morning services starting to fill up. Please pray we can buy the warehouse so we can continue to grow!

504 were saved and 270 baptized in February. We started more churches as well. Many thousands were saved out soul-winning I wish we had more transport to bring them in to church.

Martin Santana was a terrible criminal. He and his gang robbed semi-trucks with guns and sold their contents on the black market. He had all the money he wanted for drugs, alcohol and fast cars. He and his family worshiped the Santa muerte (an idol made of a skeleton representing death). This idol is worshiped by most criminals in Mexico.

Isaac a young man from our church began to witness to him. Martin outwardly mocked him but in his heart the Bible brought deep conviction. In 2008 he received Christ and his life was completely changed. He became a soul-winner. His wife and family now mocked him but he stayed firm.

In February his son Fabian was being beaten in the street by a gang. When his son Jesus saw this he came running from his small store to help his brother. They beat him to death with hammers.

Martin told me Pastor 2 weeks ago Jesus received Christ as Savior. He was reading his Bible everyday and was so amazed all his sins were forgiven! He was about to start coming to church and close his store on Sundays.

Martin preached his son's funeral and a number of his family were saved. The funeral was held in front of the house of Jesus. When Martin got home he saw things flying out the window of his house. He found his wife inside breaking all her idols of death and saints. His wife Bernarda who just got saved told the family, "From now on In this house Christ is King!"

At times people have asked me if we have the Bible in Spanish. My friend only the inspired word of God can save souls and change lives the way we have seen these 28 years.
